Thunderbolt: IPC Referral

The Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure has completed its assessment of the merits of the application for Thunderbolt Wind Farm (SSD 10807896).

Based on this assessment, the Department has considered the project as approvable, subject to the recommended conditions of consent. The Department has now referred the project to the IPC for review.

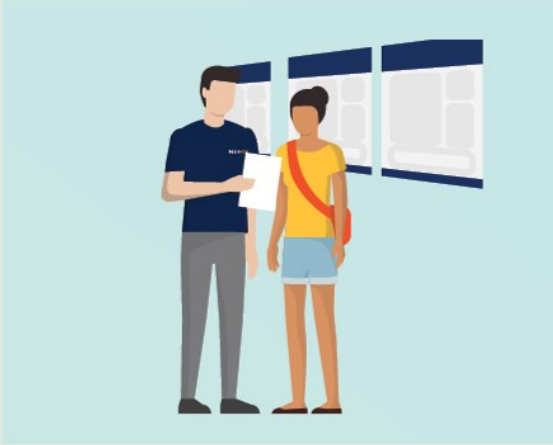
