Thunderbolt Wind Farm is a wind energy project with the ability to provide affordable, reliable power to New South Wales consumers. The project has Development Approval, and the team is currently working to fulfill the pre-construction requirements set by the NSW Government.

Project Approval May 2024

On the 8th of May 2024, the Independent Planning Committee (IPC) approved Thunderbolt Wind Farm (SSD-10807896).

This followed a site tour, meetings with the council and the public meeting that was held at Kentucky hall on 14th March 2024.

Our development team has been working hard since the approval on preparing for preconstruction. This includes detailed design, management plan approvals and secondary consents. Some plans have already been shared and approved by the Department of Planning and are publicly available here (under post-approval).





Proposal to Modify the Development Consent

We are currently preparing a modification to the Development Consent to allow for minor changes to the project, to facilitate the transport of full-length blades and accommodate updated requirements from Transport for NSW.

The modification includes the following:

- Road modification works for the route to site to allow for 100m blades, instead of the 60m split blade option.
- Minor change in the site entrance development corridor to comply with Transport for NSW design requirements for safe turns from the NE Highway.
- Inclusion of an optional microwave tower within the existing development corridor for internet (if required).
- A change in the construction timeline from 24 months to 38 months, to align with proposals received by contractors.
